Syrian civilians are experiencing the worst civil war of modern times. During the last decade, more than half the population was forced to flee the country, including 4.9 million women and children. More than 1 million people were killed, and 3 million children are at risk of losing their lives because of the .unrelenting violence in a country waging with war

That's why we created Benevolent Hands (Beyaz Eller) in 2013, to do our part in alleviating the suffering of people in Syria. We began our service with emergency relief projects intended to meet immediate needs in both Syria and its neighboring countries. With repeated forced displacement and the consequent need for quick assistance – particularly shelter, food and livelihood necessities – urgent .relief projects continue to call for international efforts

Through our work with the Syrian war-stricken population, Beyaz Eller uncovered a need for community redevelopment. In 2014, we expanded our scope to direct new efforts at development and livelihood, while continuing our work in emergency relief. Through collaborative initiatives between Beyaz Eller and our beneficiaries, we work to ensure the development of individual and community livelihoods, provide career and work opportunities to job seekers, and contribute to empowering people to achieve self-sufficiency in target areas so they can, in turn, help their communities become .self-sufficient

Redeveloping the educational system – through rebuilding damaged schools and supporting their role in reviving the educational process – has been a main focus we initiated in 2014. This effort accordingly restored and operated damaged schools, providing education to hundreds of students .and bringing back students who had dropped out of school

To provide opportunities for families and orphans who lost their primary breadwinners, Beyaz Eller .created sponsorship programs aimed at protecting beneficiaries from homelessness and further loss

We're now entering the seventh year of the humanitarian crisis in Syria – with forced displacement forging the next phase of this humanitarian tragedy. The number of IDPs in 2016 alone reached 1.5 million, the majority of whom were deported from Aleppo and its countryside, the Damascus countryside and Dar'a

With each mass deportation, the international community is challenged with providing immediate shelter and food to assist the afflicted communities with settling in relocation areas. While basic provisions are being barely met – medical, social, educational, economic and development efforts are lacking in host areas due to the current circumstances of the region This is why Beyaz Eller is furthering its efforts to create relief and development opportunities in various host governorates and areas inside Syria and Turkey. And we're proud to report that we've fulfilled nearly 2 million humanitarian acts of service

Providing long-term solutions by integrating development projects in our vision and annual plans has been a major success. By partnering with international organizations, we've implemented agricultural solutions – allowing beneficiaries the opportunity to produce crops conducive to the season at affordable prices, such as summer wheat and winter vegetables. This allows us to maintain the land's fertility and efficiency, which helps us set the foundation for intricate recovery projects

Meanwhile, we've continued our educational system efforts, and we've successfully sponsored schools to fully operate at efficient capacities to serve various regions

As we introduce our annual report for our 2016 projects, we offer our deepest thanks and gratitude to partner organizations, individuals and donors, for the sincere effort and exceptional support they provide to grow smiles on the faces of the afflicted Syrian people. And we deeply apologize for our inability to reach everyone in need due to our limited capacity and the difficult conditions that circumscribe our work

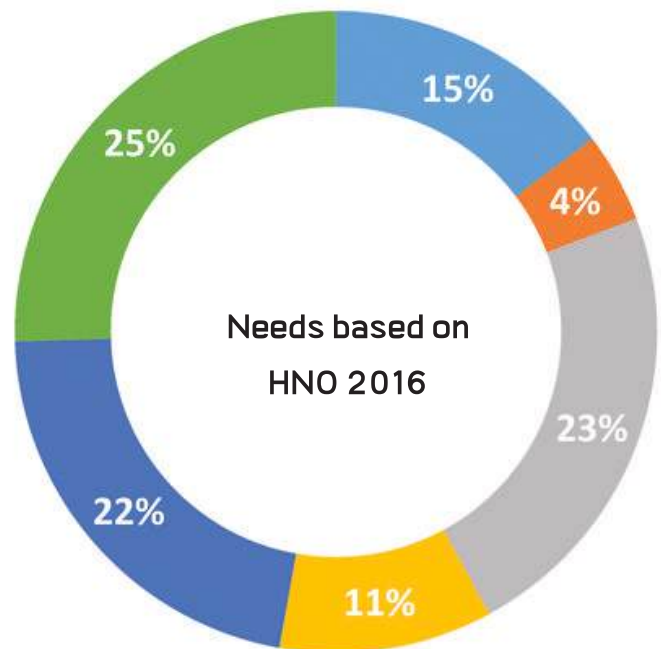
Our work is not done, however. And we won't stop until we've served every underprivileged person as he or she achieves their journey toward self-sufficiency

| Needs Analysis

Waging war has led to mass displacement in many Syrian regions. The number of refugees in neighboring countries has reached 4.8 million, while IDPs have neared 6.3 million

The continued increase in displacement rates has made the already vulnerable situation in the country more complex. More than 6,000 Syrians were displaced every day between January and August 2016. Over one million IDPs live in tents and camps, while many have resorted to living in temporary shelters. Basic humanitarian needs continue to rise in afflicted areas due to ongoing conflicts

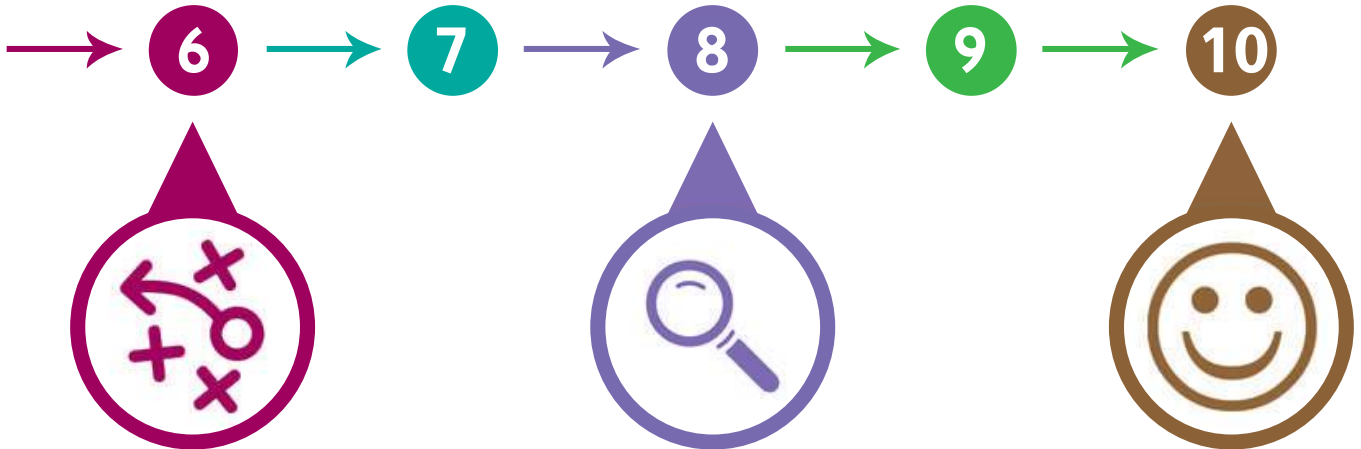

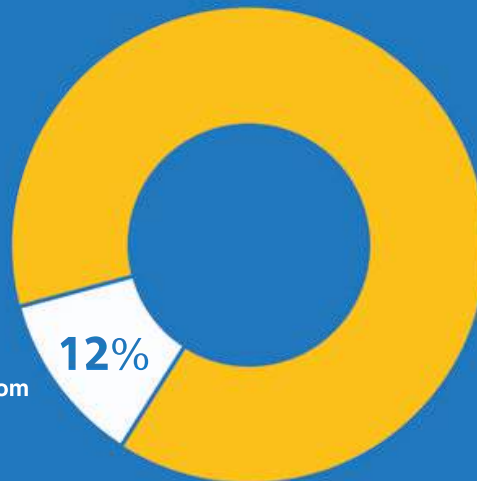


Food Security, Nourishment and Livelihood

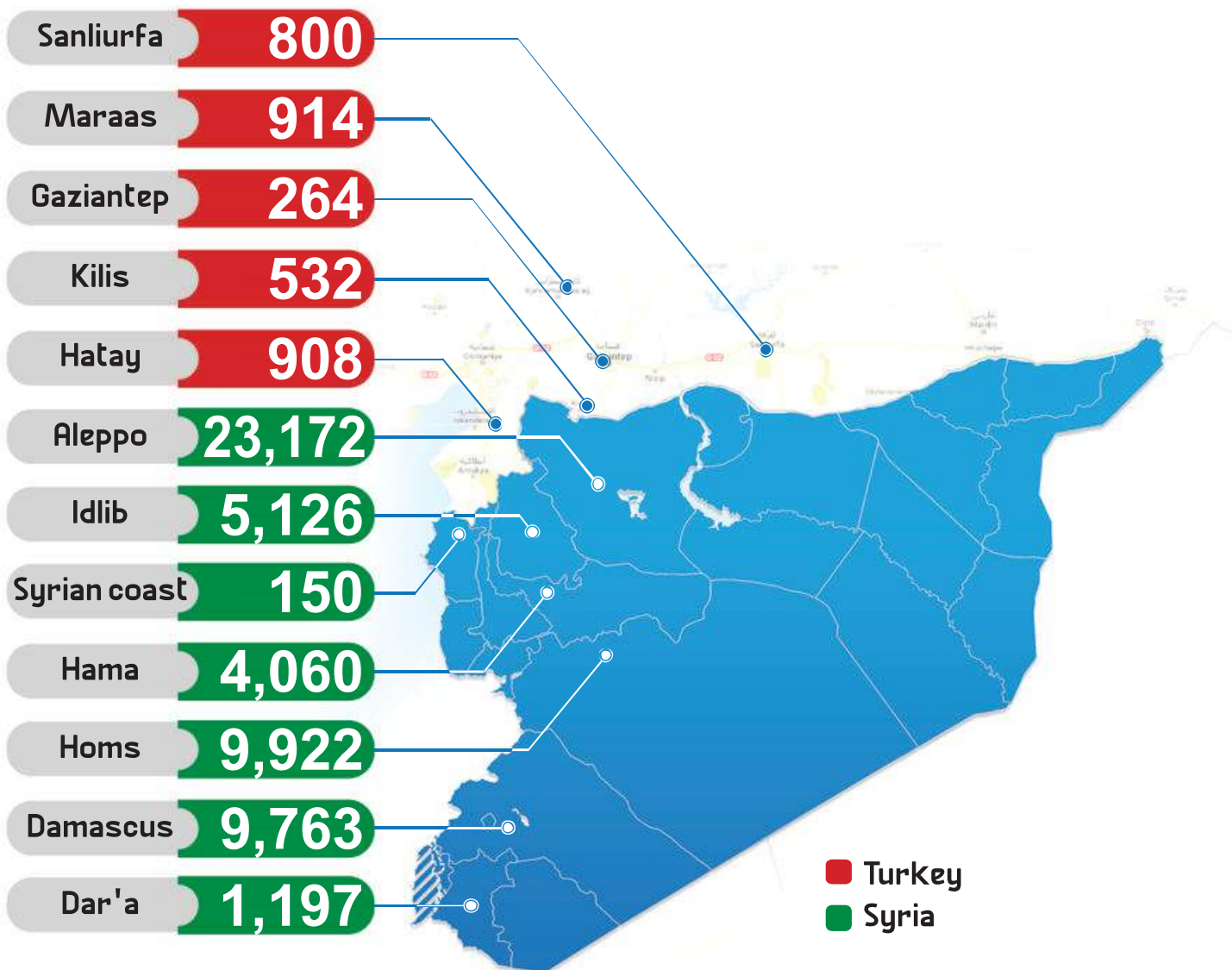

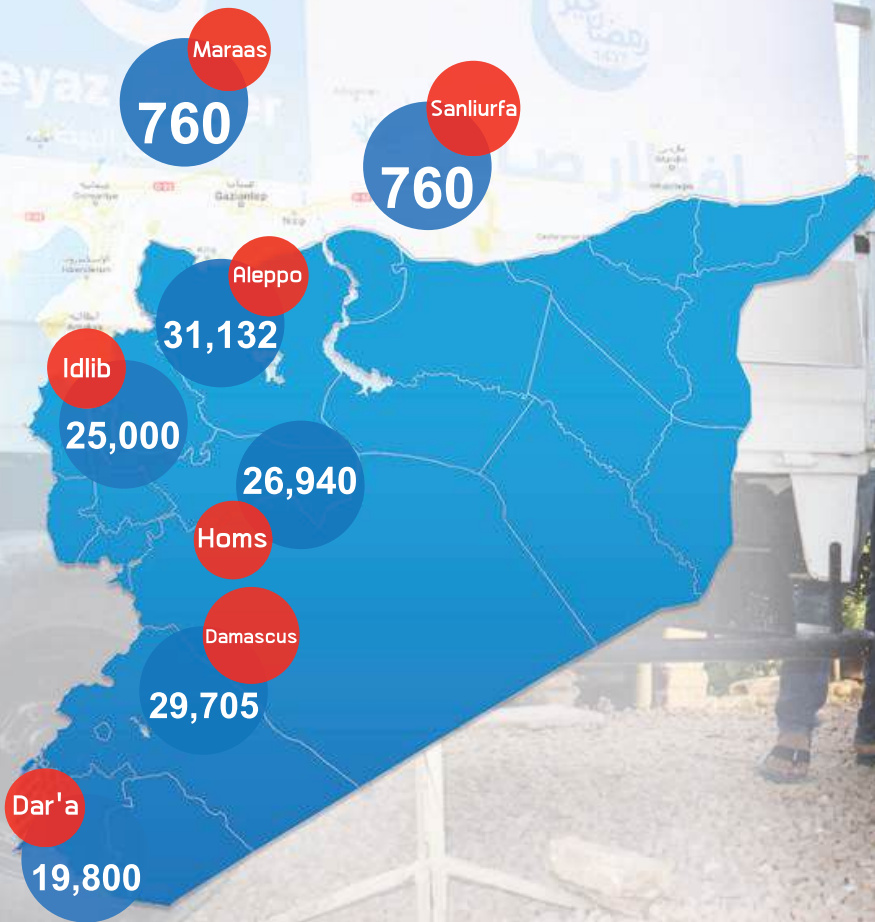

Hot Meal Distribution Map



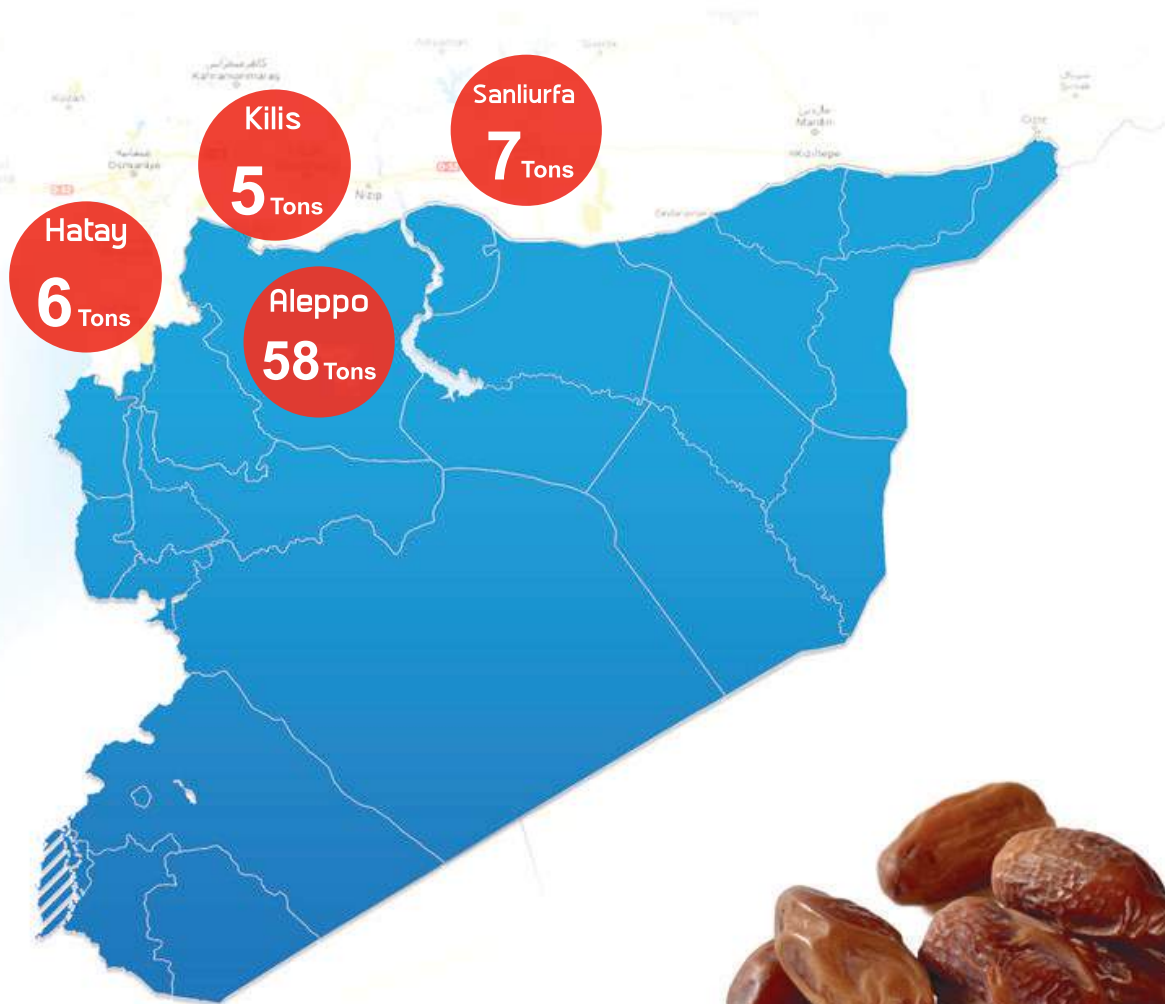

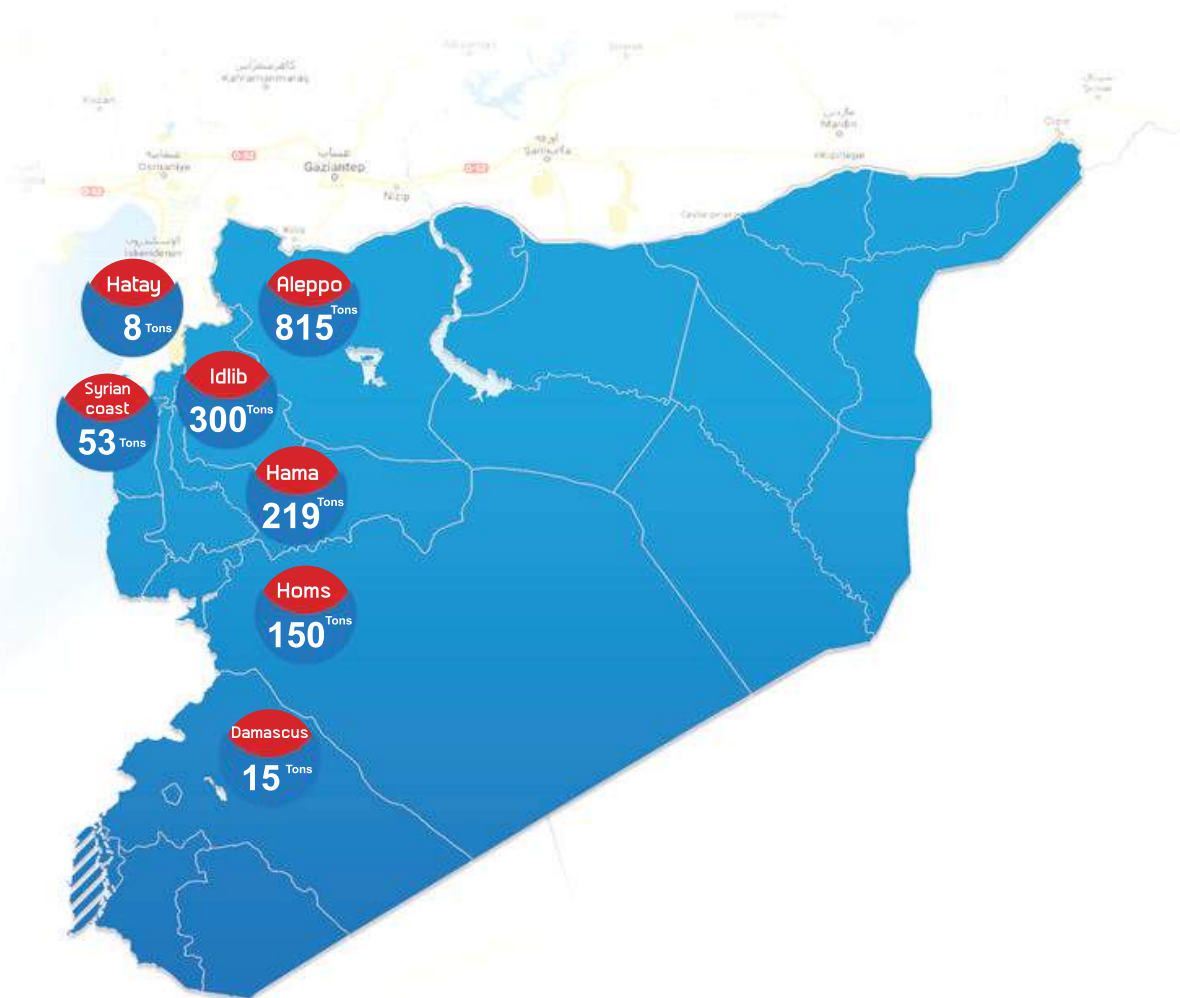

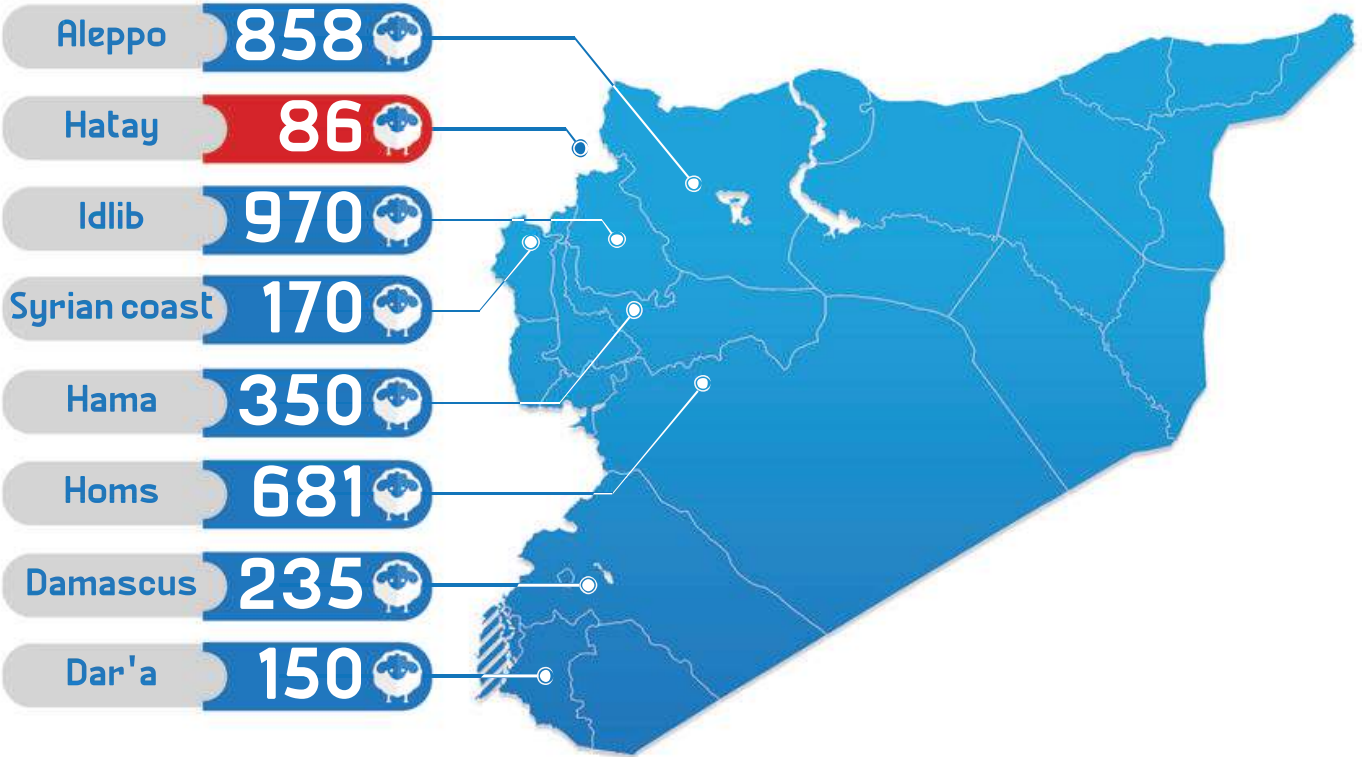

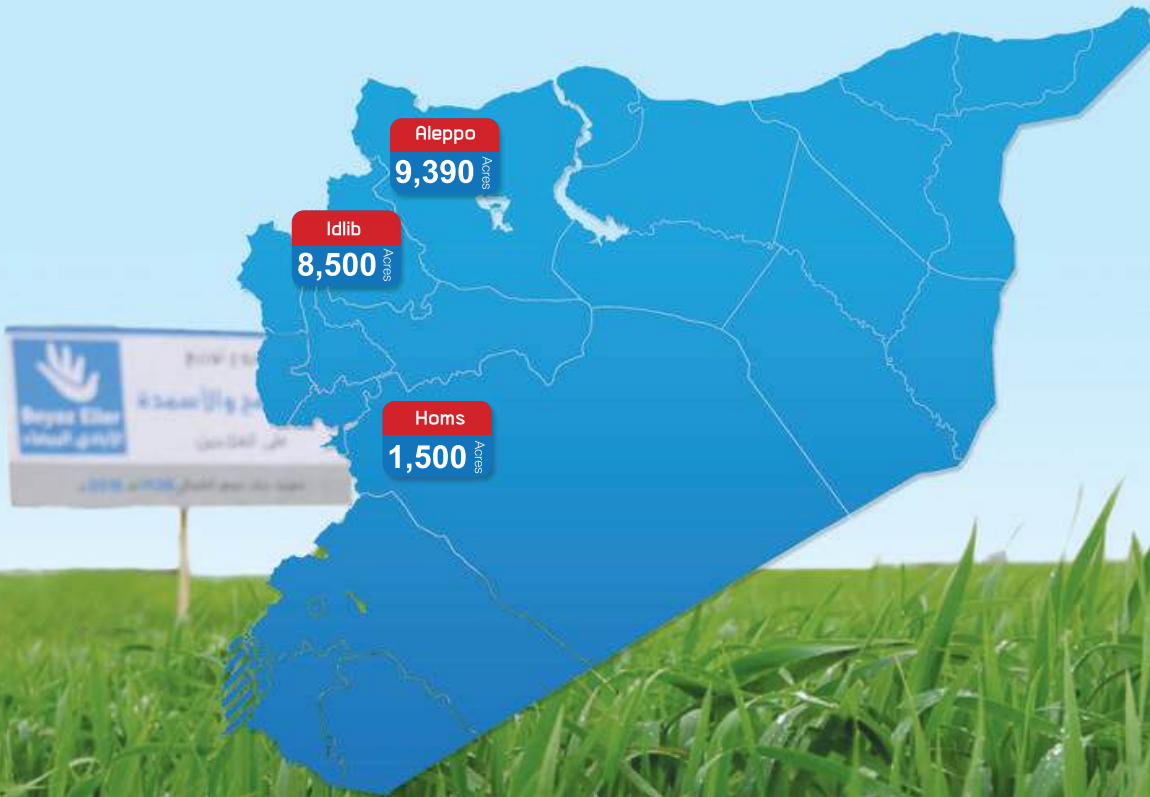

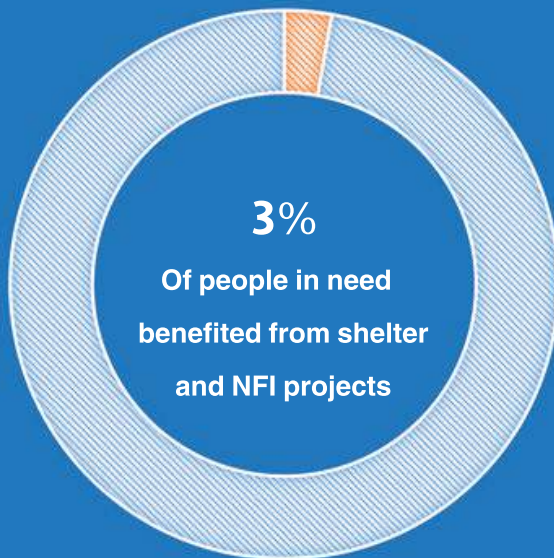

Shelter and Non-Food Items (NFI)

During 2016, the number of people in need of shelter and NFIs increased by 12 percent, reaching 5.8 million. To respond to the exponentially growing need, Beyaz Eller undertook NFI distribution projects that served 165,890 individuals, which is nearly 3 percent of all those in need.

Health and Medical Services

There are over 12.8 million people suffering from a shortage of medical care. Beyaz Eller has established a blood bank and two oxygen stations in 2015 and continues to operate them today. We've developed an ambulatory system with 5 ambulances, supply medicine to hospitals and health centers, and sponsored patients in need of kidney dialysis. In 2016, we served 28,211 beneficiaries through our medical services

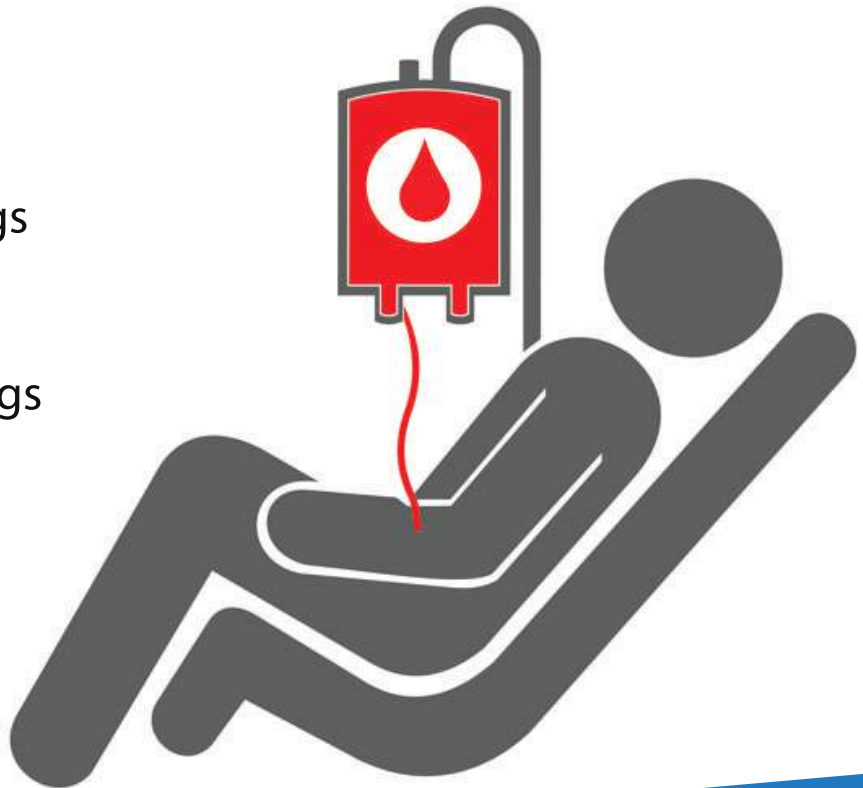

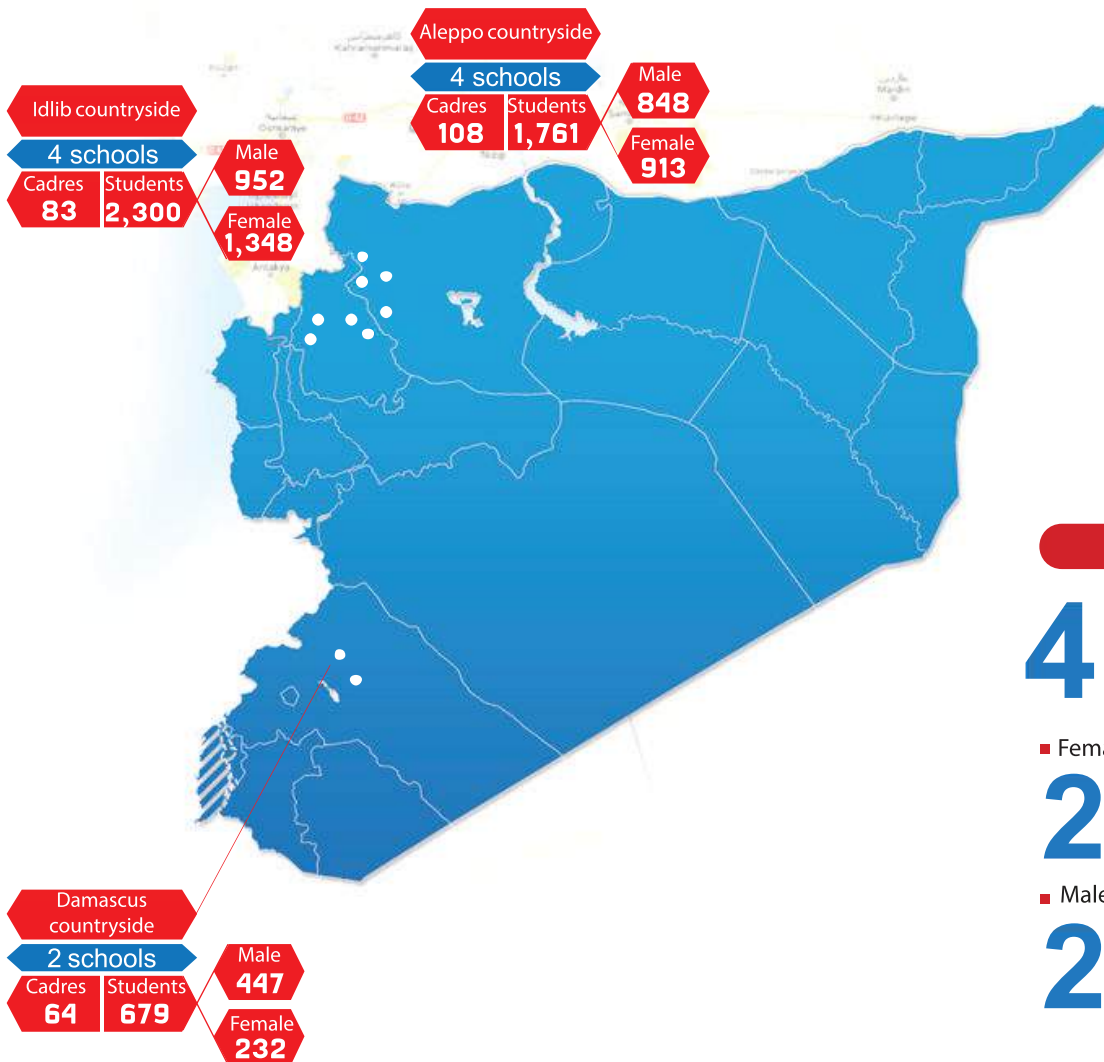

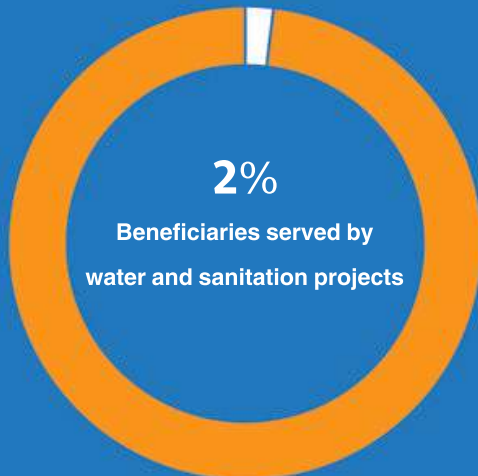

Water and Sanitation

More than 12 million people need water and sanitation services inside Syria. Families spend nearly 25% of their income to meet minimum daily water requirements. Beyaz Eller has worked to overcome the water shortage through various projects that served 235,664 beneficiaries during 2016, which constitutes 2% of those who need clean water and sanitation

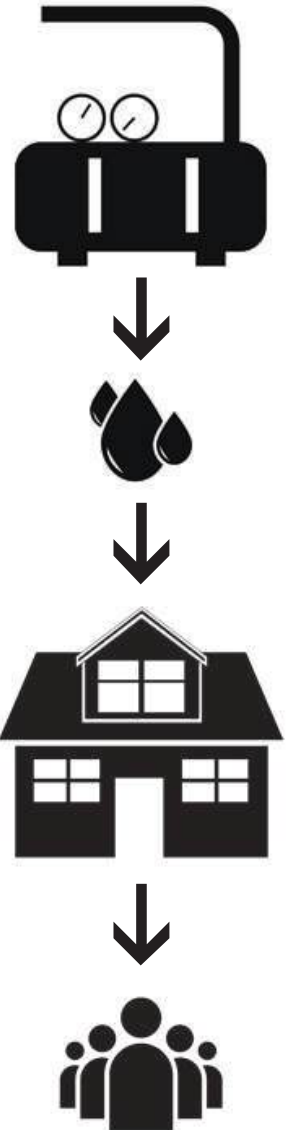

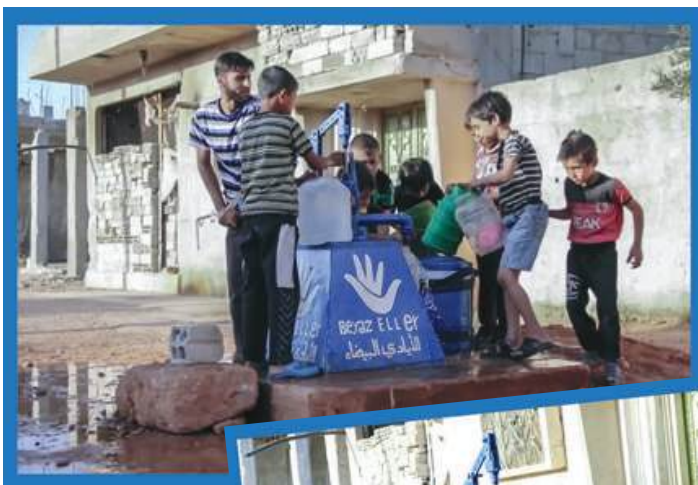

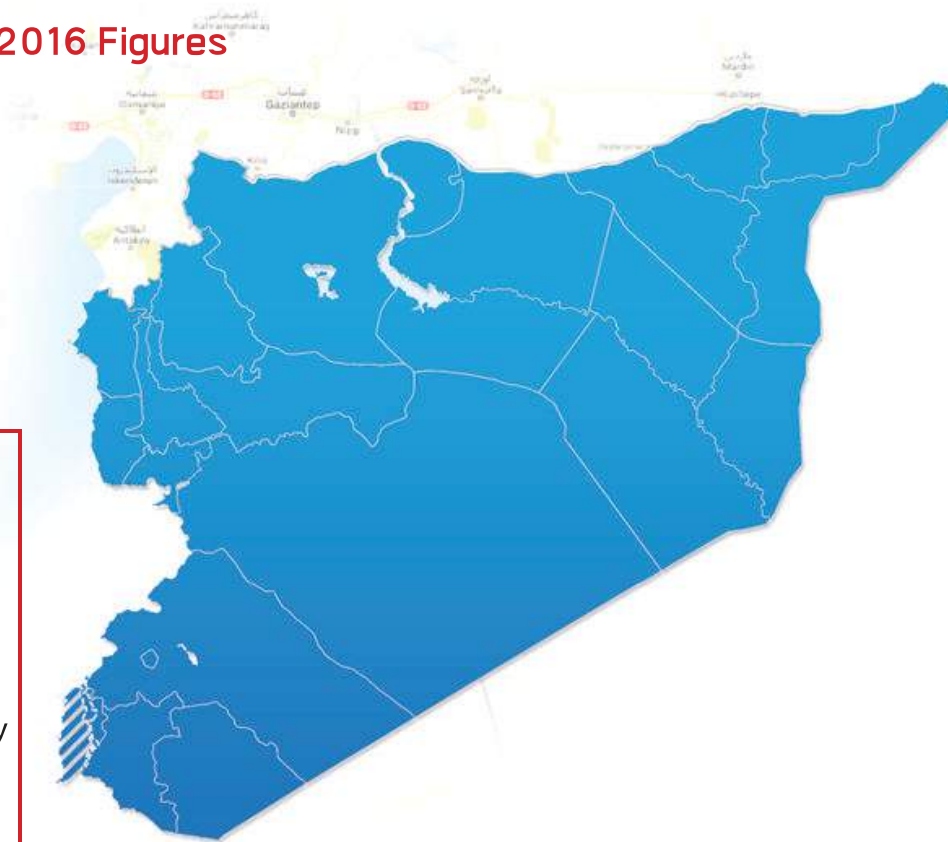
